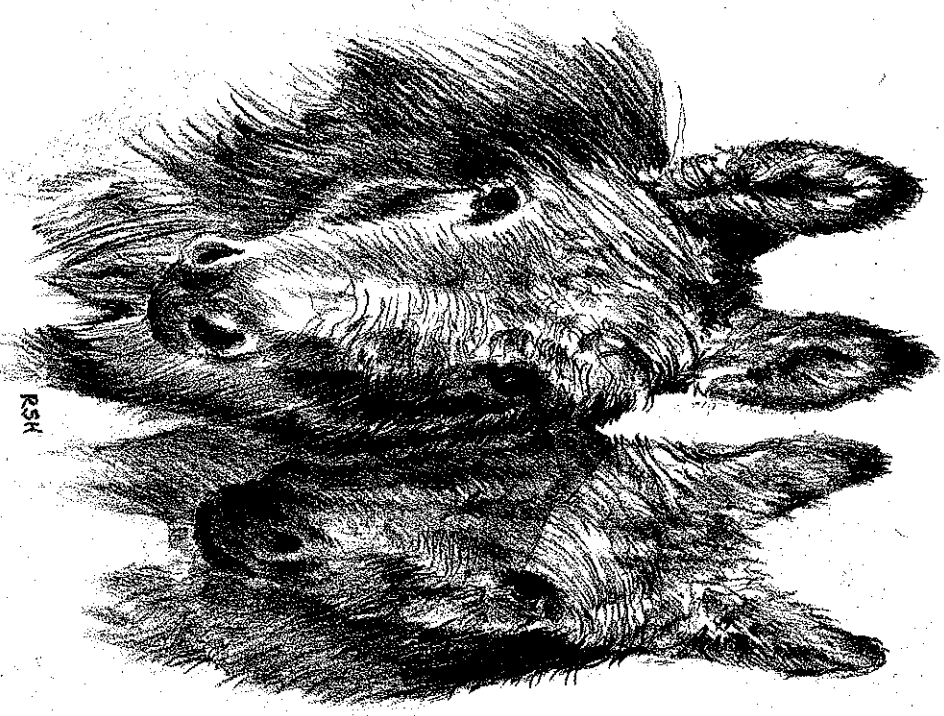
The idea of grouping them into competitive teams really spurred them on to learn and they took their knowledge home to dinner.
